Please practice the skills listed below over the summer so that the math transition from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade will not be difficult when school begins.

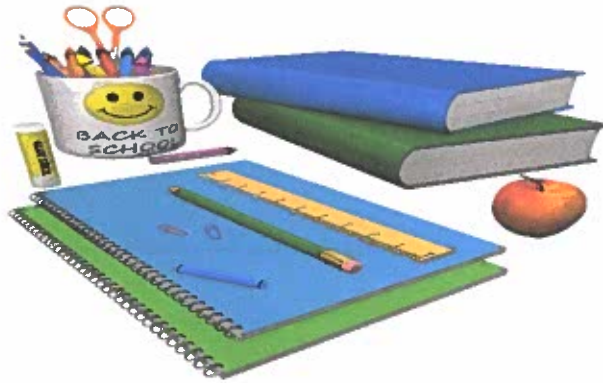
- Place value through the hundreds
